

Regulations of the City Game "Discover Gdynia on Foot"

§ 1. General provisions

1. The city game "Discover Gdynia on Foot", hereinafter referred to as the "Game", is organised as part of European Mobility Week 2026.
2. The Organizer of the Game is the Municipality of Gdynia – Gdynia City Hall, Investment Department, hereinafter referred to as the "Organizer".
3. The Game takes place from 16 to 22 September 2026.
4. Participation in the Game is voluntary and free of charge.
5. The objectives of the Game are:
 - a) encouraging walking around Gdynia and active spending of leisure time;
 - b) learning about the history, architecture, and characteristic locations of Gdynia;
 - c) encouraging residents to discover the city and spend time together;
 - d) promoting the idea of European Mobility Week and the motto "Mobility for Everyone".

§ 2. Rules of Participation

1. Any person may participate by collecting or independently downloading and printing the game card. The materials may be downloaded before the Game starts, but the tasks may only be completed from 16 to 22 September 2026.
2. Participation in the Game does not require prior registration or an application to the Organizer.
3. The Game includes 16 points located across Gdynia, each containing questions or tasks.
4. The Participant chooses which points to visit and the order in which to visit them.
5. To complete the Game, the Participant must complete at least one task or answer at least one question at each of at least 8 out of 16 points and record the answers on the game card. If a point contains more than one task or question, completing one of them is sufficient for that point to count.
6. The Participant is not required to visit all 16 points.
7. Completion time is not measured. The Game is non-competitive; no ranking or time classification is maintained.
8. The Participant may complete the tasks individually or together with other people, subject to these Regulations.
9. Taking part in the Game constitutes acceptance of these Regulations.
10. A minor may participate under the supervision of an adult who is responsible for the minor during participation in the Game.

§ 3. Completion of the Game

1. After completing the Game, the Participant may submit the completed game card to the Organizer for verification.

2. The card may be delivered in person on 23–25 September 2026, between 8:00 AM and 4:00 PM, to Gdynia City Hall – Investment Department, Dom Rzemiosła, room 302, 10 Lutego 24, Gdynia.
3. The Participant may also send a legible scan or photographs of the completed game card to mobilnosc@gdynia.pl no later than 25 September 2026.
4. The Game is considered completed when at least 8 points have been completed in accordance with § 2(5).
5. The Organizer may verify whether the submitted game card meets the completion requirements set out in these Regulations.

§ 4. Diplomas and Souvenirs

1. The Organizer provides e-diplomas and small souvenirs under the conditions set out in this section.
2. A Participant who presents a game card meeting the completion requirements in person may collect a souvenir prepared by the Organizer.
3. The number of souvenirs is limited. Souvenirs are issued while stocks last, in the order in which eligible Participants report in person.
4. Souvenirs are not sent by post, courier or any other delivery method.
5. Submitting the game card electronically alone does not entitle the Participant to shipment or reservation of a physical souvenir.
6. A Participant who submits the game card electronically and voluntarily provides their first name, surname and e-mail address may receive a personalised electronic diploma (e-diploma).

§ 5. Safety Rules

1. The Game takes place in an urban environment. Participants must exercise due care and comply with applicable laws and regulations, in particular traffic regulations.
2. Participants decide which points to visit, the order in which to visit them and how to travel between them.
3. Participants should adapt their participation to their own abilities and to current weather and terrain conditions.
4. The Organizer is not liable for damage or incidents resulting from a Participant's breach of applicable law, safety rules or these Regulations.
5. This section does not exclude or limit the Organizer's liability to the extent that such liability cannot be excluded or limited under applicable law.

§ 6. Personal Data

1. Personal data voluntarily provided to the Organizer for the purpose of receiving a personalised e-diploma will be processed in accordance with applicable data protection law, including the GDPR.
2. Detailed information on the processing of personal data, including the controller, purpose and legal basis of processing, retention period and data-subject rights, is provided in the privacy notice

attached to the game card.

3. Providing personal data is not a condition of participating in the Game or collecting a souvenir. A Participant who submits the game card electronically and wishes to receive a personalised e-diploma may voluntarily provide their first name, surname and e-mail address. These data will be processed solely to prepare and send the e-diploma.

§ 7. Amendments, Suspension, or Cancellation

1. The Organizer reserves the right to amend these Regulations for important organisational reasons or reasons beyond the Organizer's control, provided that the changes do not infringe rights already acquired by Participants.
2. Amendments to the Regulations will be published in the same manner as these Regulations.
3. If circumstances prevent the safe or proper conduct of the Game, in particular in the event of force majeure, the Organizer may temporarily suspend or end the Game early.
4. Information about suspension or early termination will be published without undue delay through the Organizer's information channels.

§ 8. Final Provisions

1. The Regulations will be available on the Organizer's website and at locations where the game card is distributed.

3. Matters not covered by these Regulations are governed by generally applicable law.
