INFORMATION ON THE PROCESSING OF PERSONAL DATA

2. The Controller has appointed a Data Protection Officer, who can be contacted at iod@gdynia.pl or in writing at the Controller's registered address.

3. If a Participant wishes to receive a personalised e-diploma, the Controller processes the provided first name, surname and e-mail address solely to prepare and send the e-diploma.

4. The legal basis for this processing is Article 6(1)(a) GDPR - the Participant's freely given consent.

5. Providing these data is voluntary and is not a condition of participating in the Game or collecting a souvenir. An e-mail address is necessary only to send the e-diploma; the first name and surname are used to personalise it.

6. Recipients of the data may include entities authorised by law and service providers supporting the Controller's IT systems or e-mail, solely to the extent necessary to provide those services and under appropriate agreements.

7. The data will be processed for as long as necessary to prepare and send the e-diploma, until consent is withdrawn earlier, and afterwards - where applicable - for the period required by the record-keeping and archiving rules applicable to the Controller.

8. The data subject has the right to access, rectify and, where legally applicable, erase or restrict the processing of their data, withdraw consent at any time, and lodge a complaint with the President of the Polish Personal Data Protection Office. Where the conditions of Article 20 GDPR are met, the right to data portability also applies.

9. The Controller does not plan to transfer the data provided on this card to third countries or international organisations. If such a transfer were connected with the use of a technical service provider, it would take place only in accordance with the GDPR.

10. No decisions will be made based solely on automated processing of these data, including profiling.
