





35 meeting rooms (1300 seats) have been equipped with the



The Danuta Baduszkowa Music Theatre in Gdynia is the largest music theatre in Poland and the second, after the Grand Theatre in Warsaw, as for the number of seats for the audience.

The usable area of the theatre is 19,000 m^2 . Various events from exhibitions to concerts, galas and performances can be organized in the theatre space, making full use of the theatre's technical potential, and cutting-edge acoustic, lighting and audiovisual equipment.

The Big Scene thanks to the extension of the theatre has expanded to **1,070 seats**. The foyer has been enlarged and has gained another floor.

The New Scene can accommodate from **300 to 360 spectators**. The stage has a separate entrance, foyer, ticket offices, changing rooms and dressing rooms.

The Chamber Scene - the smallest of the stages, the chamber stage has **147 seats**.



The permanent exhibition entitled "Gdynia – dzieło otwarte" ("Gdynia – an open work") focuses on stories provided by inhabitants, modernist legacy, and contemporary ideas. Special exhibitions expositions dedicated to design, modern projects and history of architecture have become a good tradition of the Gdynia City Museum. NEED IS SOME



The Emigration Museum in Gdynia, established on the initiative of the city authorities, is the first museum in Poland dedicated to the history of Polish emigration. The institution is located at 1 Polska Street, right on the seafront, in the historical building of the Marine Station built in 1933, from where Polish transatlantic ships set sail for decades. The aim of the museum is to present and study the stories of departures and lives of Poles living abroad in close connection with the present, as the history of emigration is in fact being written every day. Its various dimensions are shown as a permanent exhibition. Since the renovation of the Marine Station in 2014, the building has again become the city's visiting card and a tourist attraction for thousands of passengers of large cruise liners from all over the world, that moor at this very spot, the French Quay, every year.

The Emigration Museum has three conference rooms and event spaces, such as the large main hall or the foyer with an exhibition corridor. The spaces can be adjusted to the fit the nature of the event, depending on the scenario. There is also a restaurant and a bistro café at the museum, both providing excellent catering services.

The Naval Museum in Gdynia was established in 1953. The new building, opened in 2012, houses warship models, mementos, elements of warship equipment, military uniforms and distinctions. The most valuable large-size exhibits include the Bofors cannon cal. 120 mm from ORP GRYF, the Bofors waterfront cannon cal. 152.4 mm from the foreland battery, the ORP BATORY patrol boat, and an anti-aircraft cannon from ORP SEP. An annual exhibition on the warship's history is organised on the ORP BŁYSKAWICA museum ship.

The modern conference hall has the capacity of up to 120 seats and is equipped with multimedia systems to be used by organisers of seminars, conferences, meetings and film presentations.

Ship Museum Dar Pomorza ("Gift of Pomerania"), also called the "White Frigate", has been inseparably linked with Gdynia since 1929. In the course of her 51 years of service under the Polish flag, "Dar Pomorza" completed 102 training voyages, travelled half a million nautical miles, called at 383 ports. 13,384 officers of the Polish merchant navy were trained on her deck. In 1982, "Dar Pomorza" was withdrawn from service and has served as a ship museum ever since.

During the tour of the ship, visitors may view the engine room, the officer's mess, cabins of cadets, the navigation cabin, and the chief's salon, preserved in their original form since 1909.





The modern headquarters of the Academic Library, together with the Lecture and Information Centre of the Naval Academy in Gdynia are situated on two floors in an L-shaped building. 





The main tasks of the Office are connected with: maritime safety and security (including seafarer's certification), protection of the marine environment, sea routing, port and harbour regulations, performance of underwater works and marine salvage, supervision of fire protection in ports and harbours, administration of waters and sea water-covered land, as well as spatial planning of those



areas, construction, maintenance and protection of coastal embankments, dunes and afforestation, and also construction and maintenance of the port and harbour access infrastructure.

The first trolleybus line in Gdynia started its operation on the 18th of September 1943. Since then, trolleybuses have become permanently rooted in Gdynia's landscape and grown to become the city landmark.

The trolleybus is a proven technology with a long tradition. Today, cities focus on implementing measures that lead to low-emission transport and efficient use of energy resources. The trolleybus fits in perfectly with this strategy. It has always been a zero-emission form of transport, and the latest vehicles are also silent and stand out due to their smooth, continuous acceleration and braking. They are equipped with the latest technologies, including traction batteries which enable them to be driven outside the traction network, automatically controlled current collectors, or air conditioning. Moreover, electric power is supplied to the trolleybus grid from 10 traction substations. This process is managed remotely. Grid emergency services watch over its smooth operation and security 24/7. Finally, it is also worth mentioning that the company's fleet currently consists of 89 low-floor trolleybuses and 4 historic retro trolleys.

OPEN CITY WITH A VISION FOR THE FUTURE

Gdynia has always had ambitions to develop in a dynamic and thoughtful way. The development of Gdynia, its relations with business and consistent implementation of the adopted strategy have been recognized in prestigious rankings.

The key to success is the city's economic potential and the idea how to use it. Gdynia has many advantages of a modern city, which inhabitants have for many years consistently confirmed that they are satisfied with their place of residence, the satisfaction level being the highest in Poland (87% satisfied residents in "Social Diagnosis" by Prof. J. Czapiński). Many factors determine this, but one of them is certainly a high standard of municipal services: public transport, waste management and education. Management in this sector is considerably facilitated by solutions in the field of "a smart city". And in this very field, Gdynia has paved the way for other cities in Poland. In June 2017, the city received the ISO 37120 certificate. Thus it has found itself in the global database www.dataforcities.org, where each city can compare its indexes with other members of this elite group of Smart Cities such as London, Amsterdam or Dubai. Gdynia ranks really well in this list, and in some areas even excellent, which confirms the fact that that sustainable development of the city is not only a good-sounding slogan, but everyday reality.

Gdynia is also a winner in the prestigious Eco-City competition organized by the Embassy of the French Republic for Polish cities. In 2017, it won in as many as three

out of twelve categories: "Sustainable mobility", "Waste management" and "Energy efficiency of buildings". As one of the few cities, it has a special department for energy, which coordinates activities to save electricity, heat and gas, and also deals with environmental subsidies.



Gdynia has already been awarded twice in the prestigious ranking of the fDi Intelligence magazine (Financial Times Group), being ranked first in the overall category of mid-sized cities and receiving the title of "Polish city of the future". Gdynia has also been recognised as the leader in such categories as "Economic potential" and "Business friendliness". The city was ranked fourth in the category of "Human capital and lifestyle" and "Infrastructure and connectivity". The award ceremony was held during the world's largest property market event – MIPIM in Cannes.

A development of the Gdynia waterfront is an extremely prestigious project. By the very edge of the sea there is a hotel-office-residential complex with the Courtyard by Marriott Gdynia Waterfront and the highest residential building in Trójmiasto, the twelfth highest in Poland – Sea Towers. The whole investment is completed with a multifunctional office building – headquarters of PKO Bank Polski. Soon, the second stage of the project – Waterfront II – will be launched. Residential buildings, office blocks, numerous commercial premises, hotel, conference area, spa and public utilities including a cinema will be built within the scope of the planned development. Passages with a generally available square and landscape architecture which emphasizes individual functional zones of the future development, with an estimated area of 75,000 m², constitute an important part of the conception. The newly-designed development is in harmony with the modernist architecture of Gdynia. A public, but simultaneously, intimate character of the urban interiors that will be built here is human-oriented, which favours creation of good atmosphere and "life among buildings". The whole project covers areas between Waszyngtona Street and Kościuszki Square and will complement this most representative part of the city with a new public space of exceptional potential.



A city on a micro-scale, i.e. over 2,000 buildings on a huge model of Gdynia, a view from the 22 metre tower over the only street entering the sea in Poland, or a walk across the future Gdynia which is still a few years away - are only part of the offer by Gdynia InfoBox which was first opened in June 2013.

The main hall of Gdynia InfoBox is occupied by a huge 3D city plan measuring almost 8x4 metres. It is impressive not only due to its size, but also thanks to the incredible level of detail. It includes both the existing buildings, as well as those which are still being designed. It is supplemented by touchscreens which will take visitors on an interactive journey into the future.

Visitors to CultureBox will also have the option of learning about the cultural offer of the city and book tickets for the biggest events. Additionally, numerous exhibitions, presentations, and meetings take place here.

An undeniable attraction is the 20 metre-tall observation tower, accessible either by stairs or an elevator, offering a panoramic view. It enables visitors to see the progress in certain investments as well as the only street axis that enters the sea.

Gdynia InfoBox is located next to the Żeromskiego Square. A well designed green area, new street furniture, and intriguing illumination after dark, have all created an enchanting space.






Gdynia Modernism Trail

Gdynia city centre, inscribed on the list of the Polish Monuments of History, was formed in the 1930s. In the newly emerging city, there were built buildings unique on a European scale, the shapes of which brought to mind naval architecture. Round windows were designed, referring to ship portholes, oval or sharp lumps of buildings, resembling hulls of ships, additional storeys, which prototype was a captain's bridge, or external stairs like a ship's gangways. Large glazed surfaces typical of Gdynia tenement buildings, villas and guesthouses made them light and bright. They were also applied in public facilities and port warehouses. The phenomenon of Gdynia's modernism, which today's builders of modern tenement houses are trying to allude to, will be fully understood by those who cover the trail marked out between historic buildings.

The legacy of Gdynia's modernist architecture can boldly stand in line with such symbols of modernist cities as Tel Aviv or Le Havre. Like them, Gdynia was established in less than 15 years and from the beginning, the most outstanding Polish architects of the interwar period were active here. They left buildings, which delight with moderation, proportions and modernist detail up to this day. It is also worth discovering the interiors of the tenement houses in Gdynia, which despite the war have still retained original staircases.



These are unique species of fish, amphibians and reptiles from different regions of the world. You can see inhabitants of a colourful coral reef as well as animals from open ocean waters, evergreen Amazonian jungle or the Baltic Sea. Thanks to such large diversity of specimens, during the visit to the Aquarium you can meet both the heaviest snakes in the world - anacondas, the most intelligent invertebrate on Earth giant octopus, and touch (!) fish from our sea. Gdynia Aquarium, being one of the largest tourist attractions in the region, in addition to permanent exhibitions and displays, prepares numerous special events that are a permanent point on the calendar of the TriCity events. Additionally, for those who want to deepen their oceanographic knowledge, the Aquarium has an extensive offer of educational activities, during which, through experiments, work with a microscope, or games involving physical movement, participants gain better knowledge of the marine environment.
